Pōwhiri

We will have a pōwhiri and official opening on Monday 3rd February. You are welcome to stay for the pōwhiri. New families, please assemble as manuhiri - visitors in the carpark. Existing families can assemble next to junior classes. Your child/ren will go directly to class at 8.30 am and be with a teacher for the ceremony. Your child will be sitting with their class for this time. The pōwhiri will start at 9 am.

Morning drop off routine / parking

It is expected that students will arrive between 8.15 am and 8.30 am. Students are to enter through the front two pedestrian gates on McLean St. The upper gate is for Year 0-6 students and the lower gate for Year 7-13 students. We also have a pedestrian gate on Allendale Road.

Afternoon pick-up routine / parking

We have a staggered finish with **Year 1-6 students finishing at 2.50 pm**. **The Year 7-13 students finish school at 3.10 pm**. We ask that junior students are collected promptly.

After school care

Attendance
