Dear parents and caregivers,

As the year draws to a close, there are some important updates and information that I would like to share with the Elim Mt Albert community.

End of Year:

Reports will go live on Wednesday 10th December. You will be emailed the details.

School closes on Thursday 11th December at 12.30pm. We will have a short assembly on the top field to say farewell and pray for students at 12.20pm. Parents are welcome to join us for this.

Please ensure that your child has taken all of their belongings home for the end of year, this includes emptying all lockers and tote trays, checking lost property and making sure that they have all PE and sports shoes. Anything that has not been claimed by the end of the year will be donated.

Details for 2026:

Pōwhiri: School starts for all students on Monday 2nd February at 8.40am. We will have a pōwhiri for new students and staff at 9.00am. We invite all existing and new families to join us for this occasion.

Option confirmation day: Prior to school starting, all Year 11-13 students will have their option confirmation day. This is on Thursday the 29th of January. Year 11 students are to come in between 12pm and 1pm, Year 12s between 1pm and 2pm, and Year 13 students between 2pm and 3pm.

Class Lists: 2026 class lists for Y0-6 students will be displayed outside Room 1. Y7-8 lists will be displayed outside the double storey intermediate block. Y9-13 lists are displayed outside the hall. Teachers will be outside to assist students with their classes. At 8.40am, students will line up behind their teachers.

Composite Classes: We will have composite (mixed-age) classes across our Year 3 to 8 levels. Students will be grouped as follows: Year 3/4, Year 4/5, Year 5/6, and Year 7/8. These classes will be carefully considered based on each student's academic needs, social dynamics, learning behaviours, and overall best fit.

Uniform Updates:

Next year there will be some uniform changes for you to be aware of.

Year 1-6: Black, polishable leather sports shoes may be worn as a school shoe throughout the year. They need to have black soles and there should be no additional colours including logos, laces or stitching. Black polishable dress shoes can still be worn. Please see some examples of appropriate footwear below.







Year 11-13: Girls will have the option of wearing a full length black skirt all year round. The current shorter black skirt can still be worn. These can be purchased from our uniform supplier, Prestidges, in Eden Terrace.

Uniform Reminders:

Students' hair must be their natural hair colour before they return to school in the new year and boys are to be clean shaven..

Students are allowed to wear one plain round gold or silver stud or sleeper in each ear.

Hair ties need to be black, white or royal blue. Scrunchies, ribbons and bows are not part of the uniform. Smart watches are not to be worn at school.

This is a good time of year to ensure that all uniform items are in good condition.
