Please ensure that all uniforms are neat and tidy, with polished shoes. Hair should be tied back and students should not wear jewellery or makeup. All students must be clean-shaven. On Tuesday, 26th November, school will finish at 12:30 pm for all students. Please ensure you pick your child up promptly to allow time to prepare for the events and to travel into the city for the first ceremony.
