This term our Biblical theme is **God knows all about me.** Year 4 will be studying Genesis 1-4 and Year 5-6 will unpack Genesis 1-10. Our tamariki will understand that God is the Creator over everything. In Inquiry students will learn about states of matter and engage in various experiments using a range of materials to see how chemicals react.

CAMP: The Year 5 and 6 students will be attending camp from Wednesday 3 April to Friday 5 April (Week 10). More details about the camp will be sent out shortly, including a permission letter to sign up. We will require parent help for the camp, so please ensure you have an *up-to-date police vet clearance with Elim Christian College Mount Albert*. Police vets for Elim Christian College are no longer valid. Please have this underway by Monday 19 February as police vets take a few weeks to process.

HOME LEARNING: Guidelines for home learning will be pasted in the student's home learning books from Week 3 onwards. Please take time to read these guidelines. During Week 2, we will be focusing on our school memory verse and students are encouraged to read for at least 15 minutes a day. There will be no home learning sheets this week.

COMMUNICATION: Please refer to <u>our school website</u> where you can check email communications and our school Google calendar. If you are not receiving email notifications, please contact the office <u>office@elimmtalbert.school.nz</u>.

SWIMMING: The swimming pool is up and running again. Classes will have 1-2 sessions per week in the pool for most of Term 1. Please ensure your child wears full togs (rash tops are accepted) for their session. Goggles are optional and swimming caps are recommended to avoid hair entering the filter system.

DEVICES/ LEARNING PLATFORMS: Students from Year 4-6 are encouraged to bring a charged Chromebook to school every day. Some students in Year 5 and Year 6 may still be using an ipad as they are being phased out. Class Dojo is used to communicate notices with parents. More formal information will be sent through emails. Please ensure you have the Class Dojo notifications turned on. The students will use Google Classroom to post digital work.

KOTAHITANGA: Elim is a Kotahitanga - PB4L school (Positive Behaviour for Learning). Our classroom management systems are based on Elim Christian College Mount Albert values and uphold the special character of our school. We use a tino pai (traffic light system) to reward students based on the Kotahitanga values. The focus in Term 1 is Manaakitanga (respect) so students will be learning what respect looks like in various school settings. All students start on a green light and have the potential to move to the purple 'tino pai' light for outstanding behaviour. Any student not adhering to classroom expectations will receive an orange light warning (a chance to change their behaviour). If the behaviour continues, an orange light is given. Where there are patterns of negative behaviour, parents will be informed.

UNIFORM: During Term 1, students wear the summer uniform. Refer to the <u>school website</u> for requirements or the Elim uniform <u>handbook</u> page. Please ensure that all items are **clearly named** and students bring their hats to school **every day**.

WASTE MANAGEMENT AND MINIMISATION: All students are required to take their morning-tea and lunch wrappers, uneaten food, etc. home with them. They cannot dispose of it at school. The recycling bins at Mt Albert Campus have little provision for landfill items and food scraps. We would still like to strongly encourage all our parents to pack lunches in reusable containers and to buy in bulk.

BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL CARE: Carpe Diem Kids provides before-school care off-site and after-school care **on-site.** Students are dropped to school in the morning. Information about this service can be accessed via their website - https://carpediemkids.co.nz/

PARENT HELP: The school operates on the Ministry of Education's best practice. We have class trips, camps and activities planned for this year. These cannot go ahead if the adult to child ratio is not met. All volunteers are required to hold a current police clearance. As mentioned earlier, this clearance needs to be with Elim Christian College Mount Albert. If you are unsure of your current police vetting status, please check with our admin staff. If you are not police-vetted via our school as yet, please note that this takes a few weeks to process.

We have an open-door policy. Teachers are in staff devotions until 8:30 am. They are available in their classroom to answer questions and to chat about minor issues from 8:30 am – 8:40 am and again after school. Alternatively, if you would like the time to talk further, please make an appointment with the teacher. They will be more than happy to discuss the matter with you.
