Year 0-3 Trip to Auckland Zoo | Rawhi Whakaaturanga o Tāmaki Makaurau

Our Year 0-3 classes have the wonderful opportunity to spend a day at the Auckland Zoo. This will give ākongā (students) a chance to finish off and recap the social science / te reo Māori unit 'Kaitiakitanga - Guardianship and Conservation' they have been learning about this term. Our ākongā will participate in an education session, led by a zoo educator, and will have the opportunity to explore the zoo with a small group. Students will be engaged with interactive activities, storytelling and hands-on zoo examples of sustainability.

We may not require all volunteers as there is a limit on the number we can have. We are unable to take preschoolers and extended whānau on the trip.
